What does it do?

Through this kind of experiences people are encouraged to join existing local, national or European organisations or are supported to develop their own organisations for future action.

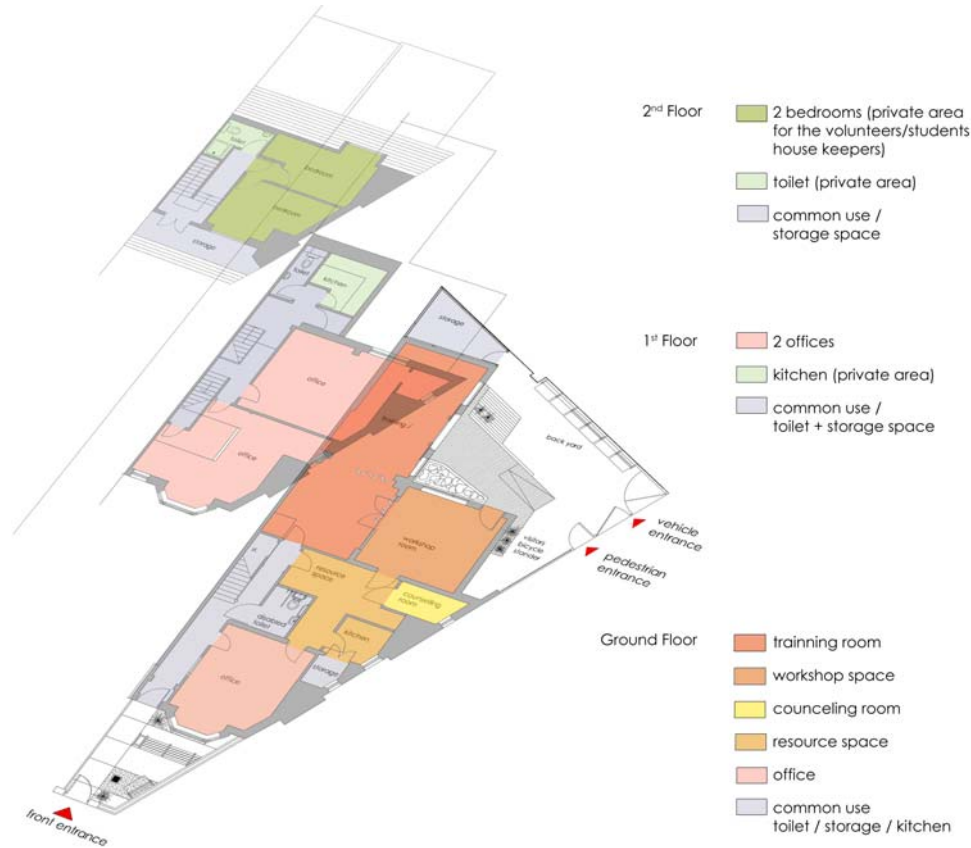
